3. Students can opt out of paying for the college courses, students will be enrolled in the Advanced English 11 or 12 courses or Advanced Western Civilization. These courses are still weighted at 1.05 but will not receive College Credit.

The Step by Step Process for CCBC College in the High School Courses:

1. Schedule with the Guidance Department
2. **Apply to CCBC online** at <http://www.ccbc.edu/ApplyOnline> for Fall 2016 by **May 27th**
 - o **On page 2 of online application:**
 - **Question 1: Click 2016-2017**
 - **Question 2: Click on Fall 2016**
 - **Question 3: Click on “College in the High School”**

- **Question 4: Anticipated Enrollment Status – “Part Time”**
 - **Question 5: Primary Education Goal is to: “Take Classes and Transfer to another School.**
 - **Questions 7 and 8: Make sure you enter Freedom Area HS and enter your year of Graduation.**
 - **Questions 10-14: You have no Prior College Information - Skip**
3. **Last day to register online is May 27th, 2016.**
 4. Once you register online you will receive an acceptance letter in the mail. And you will receive your **ID Number** on the bottom right hand corner, please save this information if you plan on enrolling into CCBC after graduation, you will already be a CCBC student.
 5. **You will need to complete the Dual Enrollment Registration Form by May 27th!** Ms. Kaplin will send the form to CCBC.
 6. CCBC will send you information as if you were attending CCBC.
 7. CCBC/CHS Admission Criteria:
 - ❖ SAT scores: 450 Critical Reading, 450 Writing, or 450 Math;
 - ❖ ACT scores: 19 Reading, 18 English, or 22 Math.
 - ❖ If a student earned a “B” average in all English Courses or earned a “C” average in Pre-Calculus.
 - ❖ If a student does not meet any of these requirements, then the Freedom Area High School Guidance Counselors can make a recommendation to verify that this student has demonstrated adequate academic preparation and the ability to benefit from advanced scholastic course work.
- **PAYMENT Requirement regarding CCBC Tuition Payment:** In order to be registered for a 2016 FALL CHS course, students/parents will need to submit a check for \$150.00 “payable to CCBC” along with the “registration form” to the Freedom Guidance Department! This needs to be completed **BY MAY 27th.** You will not be registered until payment has been received.
 - **PLEASE NOTE: IF A STUDENT FAILS THE FIRST SEMESTER IN ENGLISH COMPOSITION, PUBLIC SPEAKING AND/OR WESTERN CIVILIZATION I, YOU WILL BE PLACED IN A REGULAR ENGLISH 11 OR 12 AND/OR REGULAR HISTORY 12 COURSES FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER AND YOU WILL NOT EARN THE COLLEGE CREDIT FOR THE FIRST SEMESTER.**
 - **PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU RECEIVE A D (60-69%) FOR THE FIRST SEMESTER, CCBC WILL NOT REGISTER YOU FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER. YOU WOULD BE CONSIDERED ON ACADCEMIC PROBATION BECAUSE YOUR COLLEGE GPA WOULD BE BELOW 2.0.**
